Enter and select your name just like you would to enter a score for a competition

- 1) Select "Sign In"
- 2) Select "Supplementary Score"
- 3) Select "Sign in"
- 4) Play your round under normal competition conditions and sign your card
- 5) Enter your score into the system, selecting the supplementary you have signed for
- 6) Post the card in the box in the ladies locker room.

World Handicap System is scheduled to be introduced in November 2020 and the County will be running workshops in Q1 2020 to educate clubs.
