Committee Reports:

1. ***Treasurers Report***

Balances ; Current Account £1222.10 Reserve Account £922.70
Nancy informed us that the bank mandates need to be renewed, as a result Gill and Judie will be added to the signatory list and Lindsay and Chris removed.
Nancy asked that a separate minute be made to show the signatory changes.

2. ***Competitions Report***

Since Meg handed over the reins, there have been just two qualifying competitions. The **October Stableford** Tuesday competition was won by Debbie with 37 points, Carol was second with 34 points and third was Julia with 33 points, 10 people played. Saturday was won by Kath with a magnificent 42 points, Dawn was second with 36 points and Jane third with 35 points, 18 people played.

The **November Stableford** Tuesday competition was won by Jo with 37 points, second was Chis with 36 points, she won on count back from Yvonne who came third, also with 36 points, 22 people played. On Saturday Jane won with a great 40 points, Kath was second with 29 points and Maria was third also with 29 points, 11 people played.

The best ladies team in the **Captain's Drive** in was Chris, Kath, Hilary and Lindsay who were very surprised to find themselves leaders in the clubhouse, we can only assume everyone else played far worse than we did

The full result of the **Winter Festival** cannot be announced as the Saturday Ladies have so far been unable to play their matches. The Tuesday match was played with the seniors and good fun was had by all. Jo and Meg won with the team of Lindsay and Yvonne beating Chris and Lynette on countback for second place. Lindsay and Yvonne also won the team prize, thanks to their excellent partners John Holt and Ken Staerk who also won the men's competition.

3. Handicaps Secretary Report

October increases Gill went up to 25

Decreases Kath went down from 19 to 17 (an exceptional reduction of 0.5 was applied)

4. Captains Report

Gill suggested some possible dates when the Saturday ladies could play their Winter Tournament on either the 16th or 23rd January, weather permitting. The rules night and quiz will be held on January 14th, Gill and James, the gentlemen's social secretary will meet to discuss the arrangements for promoting this evening. The cost of the 9 holes and nibbles has been reduced to £3 as we had a £155 credit held over from last year, the captain requested that she be allowed to invite several of our past members who have retired from golf this last year to join us for the nibbles. Gill asked whether the presentation for the October and November competitions should take place at this meeting, but it was decided to carry these over to the spring meeting. A discussion was held as to what competitions had to be paid for before the cut off date at the end of January, Bradley Cook, Tappin and the Captains Cup have to be paid. Jane and Denise will be entering the Holland Cup but as Denise may not be recovered Jane would ask Jo to act as substitute. Alice has agreed to take from Liz responsibility for the Captains Cup and the 3 Feathers. Last year Dawn and Maria entered the Lohan Trophy to give Maria experience of this kind of competition, Gill will ask the Heard sisters if they wish to commit to playing the same competition this year. We discussed winter rules and agreed that this would be introduced with effect from 1/1/16, Jane will send Lindsay by email a notice which will be posted on the notice board
